## CHECKLIST WINTER CAMPING

We recommend the following accessories for winter camping: winter cover for absorber refrigerator, snow shovel, broom, plastic windscreen scraper, de-icing spray, talcum powder or Vaseline, snow mats, snow chains\*, jumper cables, a bag of sand always helps if you get stuck, snow protection bonnets for rooflights (only for permanent campers)

1.	winter tyres with sufficient tread and air pressure	
2.	switch engine heat exchanger to winter operation (red)	
3.	check engine radiator antifreeze (fill level and antifreeze content)	
4.	fill up antifreeze for windscreen wiper system	
5.	check windscreen wiper blades	
6.	maintain locks on flaps with universal oil or with non-resinous oil	
7.	check oil level	
8.	check lights and have them adjusted if necessary	
9.	check heater level and add antifreeze	
10.	switch to EisEx for safe gas supply	
11.	maintain rubber seals with talcum powder, deer talc or care sticks	
12.	deep clean (seals of windows, rooflights and flaps)	
13.	use winter supply air cover for absorber refrigerator	
14.	stow your load in a non-slip way	
15.	remove snow and ice from roof before departure
